The Swedish Internet Foundation is responsible for the Swedish top-level domain .se, with the registration of domain names and administration and technical operation of the national domain name register. The Swedish Internet Foundation also manages the operation and administration of the top level domain .nu. The Swedish Internet Foundation maintains a register of assigned .se and .nu domain names.

Privacy policy for requesting information from the domain name register

In order to manage your request for information from the domain name register, The Swedish Internet Foundation needs to process your personal data. The Swedish Internet Foundation is the data controller for the processing.

The purpose of the personal data processing is to manage your request for information. The information collected for this purpose is your email address or postal address. The legal basis for the processing is legitimate interest, as the information is needed for The Swedish Internet Foundation to be able to handle your request and to be able to hand out the information to you in a safe manner. Otherwise, the personal data that you specify in the form will not be disclosed or transferred to any third party. However, information that a disclosure has taken place may be disclosed to the data subject whose information has been requested, if the data subject exercises his/her right to register extracts.

The data in the form is deleted within 6 months after your request is managed.

You have the opportunity to ask questions and submit comments on the personal data treatment by contacting The Swedish Internet Foundation's data protection officer, dataskyddsombud@internetstiftelsen.se. That is also the address to e-mail if you want to request extracts, deletion, correction, data portability, limitation of treatment or objection to the treatment.
